PREPARING FOR A TELEMEDICINE VISIT

Using your Smart phone or your Laptop/Desktop via e-mail

If you have the equipment available please have the following ready at the time of your appointment:

- 1. Temperature
- 2. Blood pressure
- 3. Pulse
- 4. Weight
- 5. Glucose Reading (Diabetics)
- 1. You will receive a call approximately 10 minutes prior to your appointment from the Medical Assistant
- 2. They will start the check in process. You must give your permission to proceed with the Telemedicine visit.
- 3. Have your vitals ready to give to the Medical Assistant (list above)
- 4. Once you are checked in, you will hang up with the medical assistant (they will give you an approximate wait time) for the Provider to call you
- 5. If you are being contacted via phone (text) you will be asked two questions:
 - 1) Would like to access the "Camera"?
 - 2) Would like to access the "Microphone"?

Once you have allowed both the camera and microphone, your remote visit with the provider will begin.

6. If you are being contacted via e-mail on your Laptop or Desktop you will receive a link from myupdox.com. (you may have to check your junk mail or spam).
